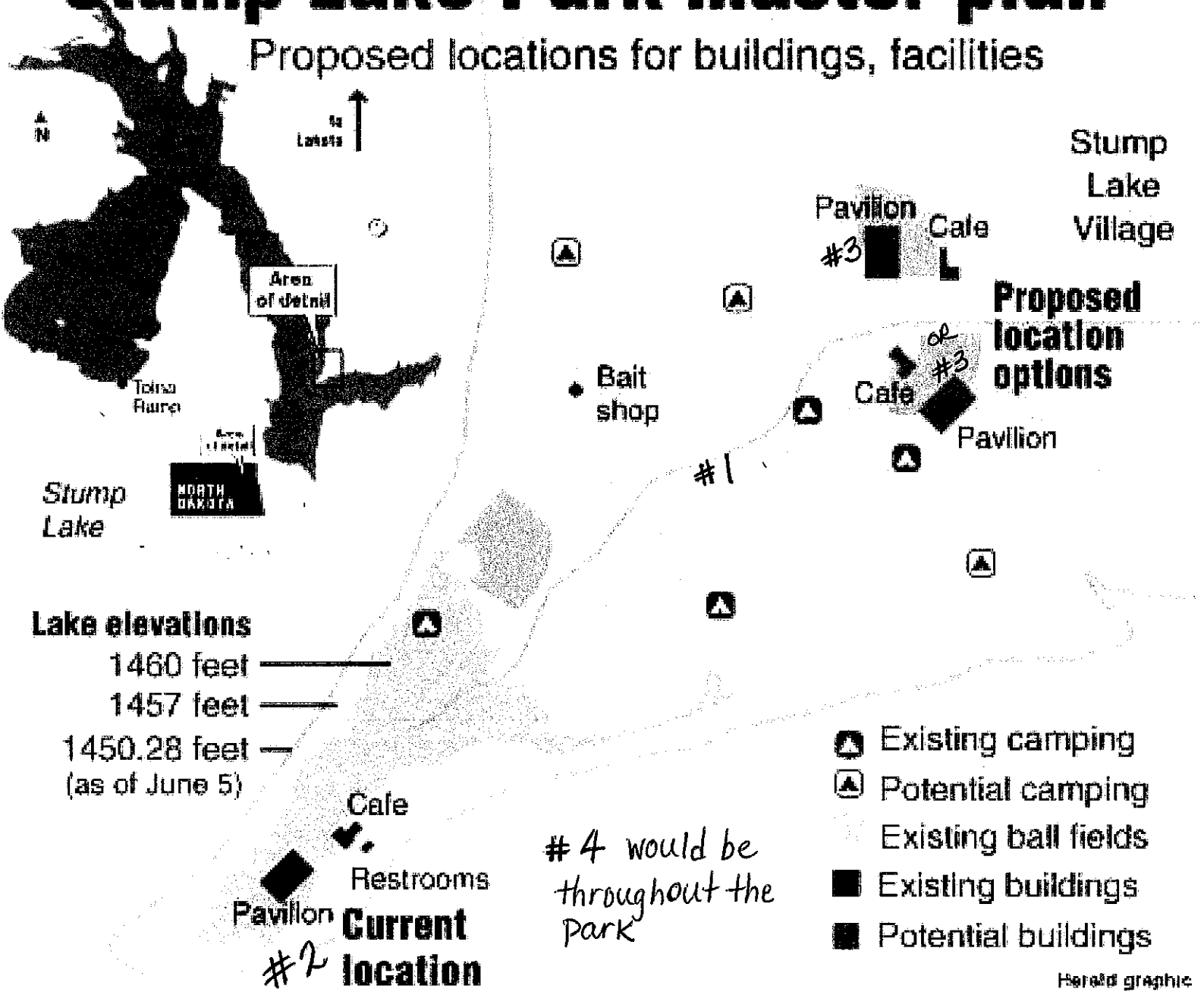

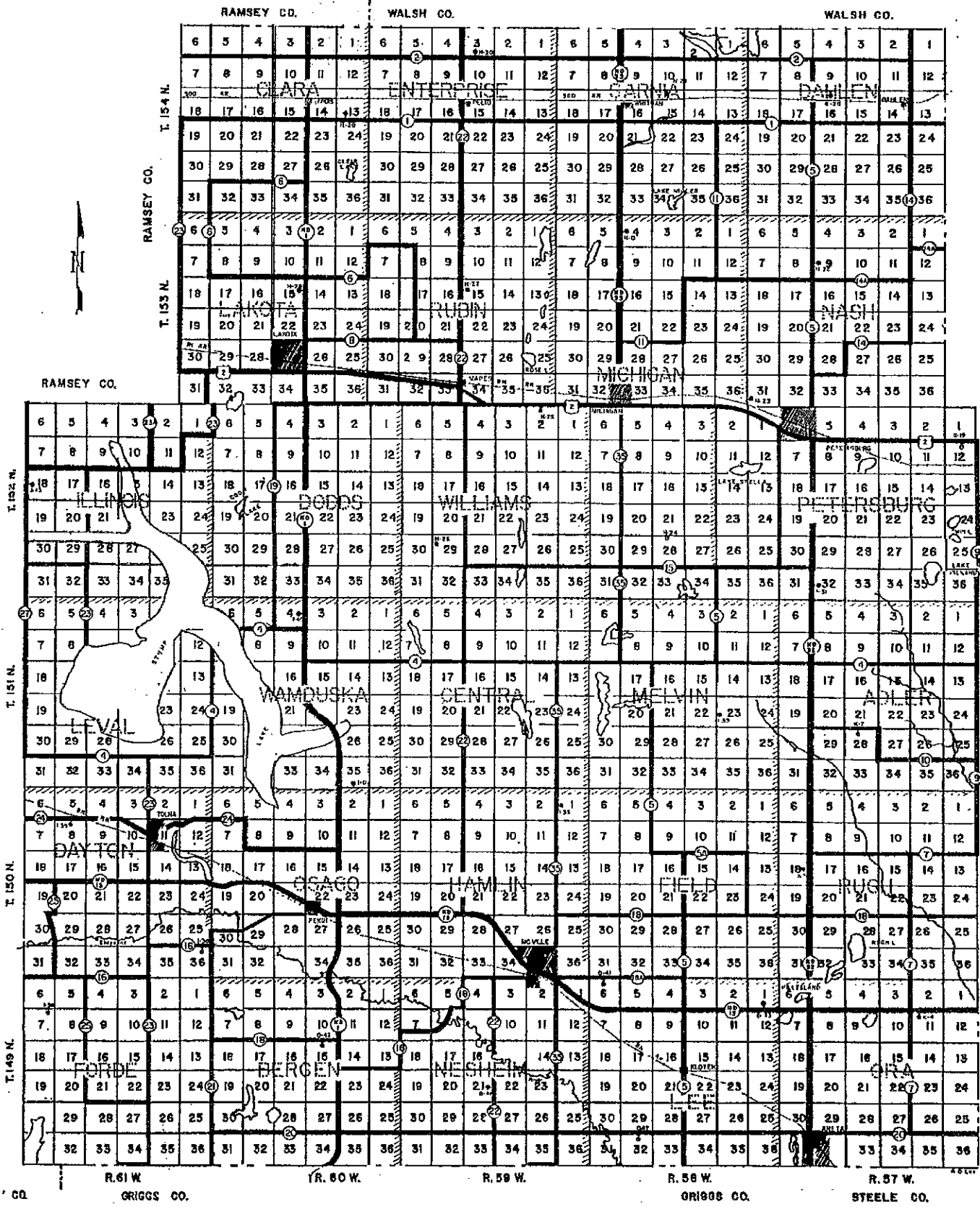
Stump Lake Park master plan
