Regular Commission Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Cody Johnson. Roll call was taken and the following members were also present: Commissioners Doug Flaagan, Mike Haugland and Aaron Mork. Also present via Microsoft Teams was Cameron Swenson.

Moved by Commissioner Flaagan and seconded by Commissioner Mork to approve the minutes from the January 21<sup>st</sup> meeting. All members voted "Yes". Motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Haugland and seconded by Commissioner Mork to approve the agenda as amended. All members voted "Yes". Motion carried.

Curt Loe, Highway Superintendent, joined the meeting to discuss Road & Bridge business.

Moved by Commissioner Mork and seconded by Commissioner Haugland to approve the abatements for parcels 15-0001-23273-000, 15-0001-23453-000 & 15-0009-24754-000. All members voted "Yes". Motion carried.
