Stump Lake Park Rules:

Nelson County is proud of its park and works hard to maintain a friendly, family park. We ask the cooperation of all visitors to help maintain this environment and that you, at all times, be considerate of other visitors. To help preserve this environment, the Nelson County Park Board has adopted the following rules.

- 1. CAMPERS:** Only hard-sided one story campers with or without a loft will be permitted on permanent camper sites. Each site may place a pop-up/tent style camper upon approval of park management.
- 2. CONDUCT OF LESSEES AND GUESTS:** All LESSEES and their guests are expected to conduct themselves in a law-abiding manner. Law enforcement will be called for anyone who is impaired and disturbing the peace and dignity of the campground.
- 3. REFUSE:** LESSEES are responsible for hauling dead leaves from your campsite to the designated area north of the café along the trees.
- 4. WILDLIFE:** Feeding of wild life is prohibited in the park.
- 5. FIRES and FIREWOOD:** Fires are allowed in steel or stone fire rings and portable fire pits. All firewood must be from within North Dakota borders. Campers may use dead or broken trees from within the campground for firewood. ALL firewood must be placed in cradles standing at least twelve inches off the ground.
- 6. FOUR WHEELERS AND UTVS:** All street legal side by side UTVs are allowed in the park during the seasons. ATVs are prohibited in the park. Operators of UTVs must have driver's license. All UTVs in the park are required to exercise due caution and follow all rules of the road. Excessively loud vehicles or speeders will be banned from the park.
- 7. MOTOR VEHICLES:** All motor vehicles shall obey speed limits and drive with due care to protect the safety of campers and pedestrians. Excessively loud vehicles or speeders will be banned from the park.

8. **GOLF CARTS:** Golf carts are permitted at the park. Drivers of carts must obey all rules of the road. Carts must be equipped with headlights and seats for each person in the cart. Loud carts are not allowed after 12:00 a.m. No one under the age of 18 will be allowed to drive golf carts without a driver's license. Carts are prohibited on nature trails after dark. All LESSEES must have their campsite number visible on their golf cart.

9. **BACKFLOW PREVENTER:** All campers must have a backflow preventer on its water supply.

10. **QUIET HOURS:** Quiet hours are from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. Excessive noise and quiet hours will be strictly enforced.

11. **NO SUBLEASING:** LESSEES may not sub-let their campsites at any time. Sub-letting will immediately terminate lease.

12. **INSURANCE:** LESSEE acknowledges that OWNER'S insurance does not cover personal property damage caused by fire, theft, rain, war, acts of God, acts of others, and/or any other causes, nor shall OWNER be held liable for such losses. LESSEE is hereby advised to obtain his own insurance policy to cover any personal losses.

13. **PUBLIC RESTROOMS:** Use public restrooms in consideration of others at the park. Any messes shall be cleaned up by those who used it immediately.

14. **GARBAGE:** All garbage must be placed in garbage cans or dumpsters to ensure wildlife does not scatter garbage.

15. **FISH CLEANING:** Nelson County and the ND Game and Fish have provided a fish cleaning station. Fish cleaning shall be done only at the fish cleaning station. Fish remains shall not be deposited in any dumpsters. Report any problems with the fish cleaning station to park management immediately.

16. **DOCKS AND FISHING PIERS:** Nelson County and ND Game and Fish have provided docks and fishing piers for the use of all visitors and campers. Be courteous and allow access to all. Private dock owners are required to provide proof of liability insurance to Nelson County Park Board, 210 B Ave Ste. 201, Lakota, ND 58344.

17. **FIREWORKS:** Fireworks shall be used at only designated areas at the park on July 3rd and July 4th. Fireworks are PROHIBITED during any other time.

18. **PETS:** Pets must be leashed and tied at all times. A leash may be no longer than fifteen feet in length. Pets owners must pick up after pets. Pets are not allowed in public bathrooms, showers, or café/pub. Disruptive barking and growling will not be tolerated in the park.

VIOLATION OF ANY RULES may result in you being told to leave the park by a park employee. Repeat offenders may be barred from the park. Persons who do not leave when directed to leave will be arrested.

Additional Rules for Seasonal Campers:

19. **CAMPERS:** Only hard-sided one story campers with or without a loft will be permitted on permanent camper sites. Each site may place a pop-up/tent style camper upon approval of park management. LESSEE may do this by exercising an additional camper agreement and payment of \$400.

20. **ADDITIONAL STRUCTURES:** Sheds, canopies, decks, and gazebos are permissible in permanent sites. Any deck may not be larger than the total footprint of the camper with the slides extended. Storage sheds shall not exceed a combined total of 400 square feet and each site is limited to 2 sheds. Canopies shall not exceed 500 square feet and each site is limited to 2 canopies. Gazebos shall not exceed 250 square feet and is limited to one. All decks, sheds, canopies, and gazebos must be approved by Park Management prior to being constructed.

21. **APPEARANCE AND GROOMING OF CAMPSITE:** Permanent campers shall keep their site appearance neat and orderly. Written notice may be given to those LESSEE whose sites are in disrepair. LESSEE is required to repair deficiencies within thirty days of written notice. Nelson County Park Board shall be informed at the monthly meetings of the violations and any terminations.

22. **WATERING GRASS:** Watering of grass is prohibited from 5 p.m. Friday until 5 p.m. Sunday. Watering of grass is prohibited from 5 p.m. Friday until 5 p.m. Monday Memorial Day Weekend, 4th of July Weekend, and Labor Day Weekend. Watering grass with timers is prohibited.

23. **FIRES and FIREWOOD:** Campers may cut live trees with permission of park management.

24. **LEASE DOES NOT TRANSFER UPON SALE:** Lease of campsite does not transfer upon sale of camper. If camper is sold it must be removed from leased camping spot. New campers shall be determined by being the next on the list.

25. **CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE:** Nelson County Stump Lake Park Board uses the “three strike rule” First violation—written notice; Second violation—written notice; Third violation—written termination of campsite lease—no refunds will be given if lease is terminated. Nelson County Park Board shall be informed at the monthly meetings of the violations and any terminations.

VIOLATION OF ANY RULES may result in you being told to leave the park by a park employee. Repeat offenders may be barred from the park. Persons who do not leave when directed to leave will be arrested.
