Nelson County Emergency Management is inviting all Nelson County residents to participate in the Nelson County Hazard Mitigation Plan Second Planning Meeting. The meeting will be held Thursday, July 30th at 6:00 PM via virtual meeting/teleconference. The purpose of the meeting is to review the fourteen Hazard Annexes in the plan (civil disturbance, criminal, terrorist, nation attack, cyberattack, dam failure, drought, wild and urban fires, flood, geological hazards, hazardous materials release, infectious disease and pest infestations, severe summer weather, severe winter weather, space weather and transportation incident) for updates and input from the community, if you feel you have expertise or knowledge of any of these areas and would like to contribute to the process by reviewing any of these annexes and/or participate in the planning meeting please contact Angela Herda at 701-247-2472 or aherda@nd.gov. The community needs your valuable insight into this collaborative effort.

Through the hazard mitigation planning process, Nelson County and its communities can identify hazard mitigation measures. Counties with an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan become eligible for Hazard Mitigation Grants which provide funding for sustained actions taken to reduce or eliminate long-term risks from hazards.
